## Women's Day Celebration on 13.03.2023





It was attended by Principal, Head of various departments and anti-ragging committee along with BDS 1<sup>st</sup> Year students.


In this programme guest speaker Dr. Anil K Chandna shared their views on anti-ragging and explained the following objectives.

**WORLD'S TUBERCULOSIS DAY -24<sup>th</sup> March 2023**

The Department of Public Health Dentistry & Microbiology of I.T.S Dental College, Hospital & Research, Greater Noida celebrated “World Tuberculosis Day” with the theme “Yes! We can end TB!” on 24<sup>th</sup> March 2023 to educate public about the impact of TB around the world. This annual event commemorates the date in 1882 when Dr. Robert Koch announced his discovery of Mycobacterium tuberculosis, the bacillus that causes tuberculosis (TB).



1. On this Occasion, the lecture on Tuberculosis and its impact was delivered by Dr. Nitika Anand from the department of Microbiology. She beautifully outlined the global & Indian scenario. Also, She highlighted the major causes & symptoms of TB. The students took active participation.

2. The camp was organized by the Department of Public Health Dentistry at Sikandrabad. 148 Oral Health Screening were done at the camp venue along with the basic treatments like scaling, Fillings and Extractions. Free Medications like analgesics &

antibiotics were distributed to those patients who were in need.

3. All the patients visited the Dental Camp were sensitized, regarding the ill effects of smoking and other risk factors for tuberculosis. Also they were aware of the precaution one could take to prevent this and the treatment options available today.
4. A Nutritional Food Box was provided to the TB patients which includes biscuits, groundnuts, chana, gur, sattu etc.





## Report on No Tobacco Day: 31<sup>st</sup> May 2023

The Department of Public Health Dentistry of I.T.S Dental College, Hospital & Research Centre, Greater Noida celebrated “**No Tobacco Day**” on 31<sup>st</sup> May 2023 to motivate patients, students and professionals.

### **Series of events organized at the camp venue (Surajpur, Greater Noida) and at I.T.S – Dental College, Hospital & Research Centre, Greater Noida**

1. On this occasion, Dr. Chandan Soni, Deputy Chief Medical Officer, Gautam Budh Nagar district was invited. He addressed the gathering about the harmful effects of tobacco consumption, and also discussed the coping strategies one should adopt.
2. Apart, from that, Dr. Shweta Khurana, district consultant, non-communicable disease, from CMO office, Gautam Budh Nagar discussed the benefits of quitting tobacco.
3. Tobacco Cessation Booth were installed. The patients visiting the OPD of I.T.S Dental College, Greater Noida were sensitized regarding the ill effects of Tobacco consumption. Carbon monoxide monitoring was done with the help of Smokerlyzer in order to assess CO in breath of patients who smoke.
4. Pamphlets depicting the harmful effects of tobacco consumption and ways to quit them were distributed to those strata of patients with the habit, visiting the OPD of ITS Dental College.
5. The camp was organized by the Department of Public Health Dentistry at Surajpur, Greater Noida. 128 Oral Health Screening were done at the camp venue along with the basic treatments like scaling, Fillings and Extractions.
6. Tobacco cessation counseling were done to the patients who were in the habit of smoking or chewing tobacco at the camp venue Surajpur, Greater Noida & at Tobacco Cessation Clinic.
7. Pledge was taken by faculty, students and the patients in order to not to smoke in future and encourage others to leave this harmful habit.
8. At the end, “Signature campaign” was initiated by Dr. Chandan Soni, Deputy CMO, Gautam budh nagar & the principal of ITS Dental College, Greater Noida Dr. ,Sachit Anand Arora. followed by students to not to smoke or use any tobacco products now and forever.
