



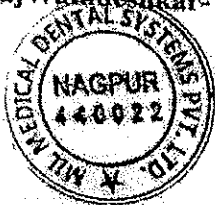

(b) If either party believes the stated purposes of this MOU are not being fulfilled, the other party shall be notified of the areas of concern in writing. Both parties shall attempt to resolve those concerns through common efforts. If no solution can be achieved, either party may terminate this MOU by providing written notification at least (2) two months in advance; provided, however, that such termination shall not affect the on-going programmes if any.

(c) If the termination is for the other party's non-compliance with any material term of this MOU, the party desiring to terminate will contact the other party in writing, and such party shall have thirty (30) days to correct the situation (cure period). If the situation is not corrected after the thirty (30) days cure period, the termination shall be effective immediately following the thirty (30) days cure period; provided, however, that such termination shall not take effect with respect to the on-going programmes if any.

(d) The parties may immediately terminate this MOU in the event that there is a change in law, regulations or policy of the Government which are not in conformity with the terms and conditions of this MOU.

#### **IV. FORCE MAJEURE**

If as a result of an act of force majeure, including without limitation, an act of nature, war, riot, labour dispute, strike, threat thereof, intervention of a Government agency or instrumentality, or other occurrence beyond the reasonable control of either party, a party is hindered in performing its obligations here under or is there by rendered unable to perform its obligation here under, then, in such event, such party shall have the right, upon notifying the other of the occurrence of force majeure as here in defined, to suspend performance until the event of force majeure has passed. In the event that either party is unable to perform or a period in excess of two (2) months at any time after the commencement date of this MOU due to an act of force majeure, the other party may, at its option, terminate the MOU.

#### **V. DISPUTE RESOLUTION**

## AGREEMENT OF COOPERATION

BETWEEN

**TUFTS UNIVERSITY, SCHOOL OF DENTAL MEDICINE, USA**

AND

**I.T.S. GROUP OF DENTAL INSTITUTIONS,  
GHAZIABAD, GRATER NOIDA, U.P. INDIA**

The Trustees of Tufts College, USA, on behalf of Tufts University School of Dental Medicine ("Tufts") and I.T.S. Dental College, India ("I.T.S.") hereby enter into an agreement of cooperation, made as of the 28th day of October, 2014, to establish a program of exchange and collaboration in areas of interest and benefit to both institutions.

### I.

The purposes of the cooperation between Tufts and I.T.S. are as follows:

- to promote interest in teaching activities of the respective institutions, and
- to deepen the understanding at each institution of the economic, cultural and social issues relating to its counterpart.

### II.

To achieve these goals, Tufts and I.T.S. may investigate opportunities in the following areas, insofar as the means of each allow:

- promote institutional exchanges by inviting faculty and staff of the other institution to participate in a variety of teaching, activities and professional development;
- receive students of the other institution for periods of study. It is understood that acceptance of any students will be at the discretion of the institution providing the learning experience, and that any visiting students will be responsible for his/her own

living expenses and will, at all times, be subject to the policies and regulations of the institution providing the learning experience and its community.

- organize symposia, conferences, short courses and meetings.
- carry out continuing education programs; and
- exchange information pertaining to developments in teaching and student development at each institution.

### III.

Each department within the respective institutions desiring to participate in an exchange shall designate a coordinator to oversee and facilitate the implementation of this Agreement. The coordinators, working with other appropriate administrators at the respective universities, shall have the following responsibilities:

- to promote academic collaboration at both faculty and graduate student levels;
- to act as principal contacts for individual and group activities and to plan and coordinate all departmental activities for which cooperation with the other institution is desired;
- to distribute to each institution information about the faculty, facilities, publications, library materials and educational resources of the other institution; and
- if deemed desirable, to meet periodically to review and evaluate past activities and to work out new ideas for future cooperative agreements.

### IV.

This general Agreement of Cooperation shall be identified as the master document of any program agreement executed between the parties. Further agreements concerning any program shall provide details concerning the specific commitments made by each part and shall not become effective until they have been reduced to writing and executed by the duly authorized representatives of the respective institutions. The scope of the activities under this agreement shall be determined by the funds regularly available at both institutions for the types of collaboration undertaken and by financial assistance as may be obtained by either institution from external sources. No specific financial commitment by either party is to be implied from this agreement.

### V.

Except as may be stipulated in any specific program agreement, each institution shall be responsible for expenses incurred by its employees under this agreement.

VI.

Upon approval by each institution, this agreement shall remain in effect until October 28, 2017 unless terminated earlier by either institution. Such termination by one institution shall be effected by giving the other institution at least ninety (90) days advance written notice of its intention to terminate. Termination shall be without penalty. If this agreement is terminated, neither Tufts nor I.T.S. shall be liable to the other for any monetary or other losses which may result from such termination.

VII.

This Agreement may be executed in multiple counterparts. This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of The Commonwealth of Massachusetts, without regard to conflicts of laws provisions.

VIII.

I.T.S. shall not use the name "Tufts" or "Tufts University" or the name of any school or division thereof, or use any logo or insignia of or otherwise identify Tufts or any school or division thereof, in any form of publicity or disclosure without the prior written consent of Tufts, which consent may be withheld or granted by Tufts in its sole and complete discretion at any time or times. Tufts University shall not use the name "I.T.S. Dental College" or the name of any school or division thereof, or use any logo or insignia of or otherwise identify BBD or any school or division thereof, in any form of publicity or disclosure without the prior written consent of I.T.S., which consent may be withheld or granted by I.T.S. in its sole and complete discretion at any time or times.




