भी रूप में तम्बाकू का सेवन मुंह के कैंसर का प्रमुख कारण बन सकता है। जो महिलाएं तम्बाकू का सेवन करती हैं उन्हें सर्वाइकल कैंसर होने का खतरा रहता है। नीरंजलि स्वयं सेवी संस्थान की संस्थापक एवं अध्यक्ष सारिका बहेती ने बताया एल्कोहोलिज्म को अल्कोहल यूज डिसऑर्डर के नाम से भी जाना जाता है। यह एक ऐसी स्थिति है जिसमें किसी इंसान के मन में अल्कोहल या शराब पीने की रोज इच्छा होती है। फिर
